Eligible Students: The children and grandchildren of eligible CBAI-member bank employees, directors, and officers — or a part-time bank employee — who are entering their freshman year of undergraduate school or post-high school trade school as a full-time student.

Submission:

A bank may submit

- one nomination for \$2,500;
- two nominations for \$5,000;
- four nominations for \$10.000:
- 10 nominations for \$25,000;
- 12 nominations for \$50,000; and
- 16 nominations for \$100,000.

Drawing: Students' names are put into a drawing to take place during the CBAI Annual Convention. Representatives of the sponsoring bank need not be present to win.
