Commercial loans don't always follow the "normal" pattern. Each one is unique. These loans carry the most risk, the most technical requirements, and therefore receive the most examiner scrutiny. This session ventures beyond the basics and explains the protections and safeguards to put in place when drafting a loan. It reviews the documentation for a commercial loan, including collateral security documents; addresses underwriting best practices; and explains how to avoid hazards. This must-attend webinar is for commercial lenders seeking more advanced training in this area.

- Identify parties to the loan and know who needs to sign what
- Understand loan agreement covenants and when to consider more than the boilerplate covenants

- Review title insurance policies and be aware of certain endorsements and exceptions
- Explain subordination agreements, including when to get them, what is actually being subordinated, and when to ask for subordination of loans to shareholders
- Document commercial construction loans
